

HOUSING & LIVING WITH DISABILITY



In WA, there are est. **411,500 people** who **experience disability** that restricts their everyday activities



Around **1/3 of people with disability** are living in **rented accommodation**



16% of people with disability who are renting are living in **social housing**



Almost **25%** of adults with disability **live alone** compared with **10%** adults without disability



Less than 5% of existing housing stock would be **suitable** for a **person living with a mobility disability**



Households including a person **with disability** are much more likely than those without to have a **low weekly income**. This places people with disability at greater risk of housing stress and housing insecurity



People who have **experienced homelessness** are **more likely** to have a long term health condition, a mental health condition or other **type of disability**
